Camp Counselors

The counselor is a key person in fulfilling the purpose of the camp. He/she will act as friend, advisor, guide, parent, and big brother/sister to the children in their group. They are responsible for leading their group of children in daily activities while loving, individualizing and directing each child toward a first time, or closer relationship with Jesus Christ. Counselors supervise children 24 hours a day Sunday to Friday, with scheduled special activities and daily “breather” times.

Support Team * Most of the Support Team will also be assigned to other camp program-related responsibilities in the evenings.

Cook Asst.(s) Assisting Head Cook in preparing meals and overseeing the High School Team Staff in fulfilling their responsibilities in the Kitchen/Dining Area.

Craft Instructor Preparing daily craft projects, instructing children and maintaining the Craft Shed.

Lifeguard Safety and instruction of campers in pool areas, and assisting in maintaining the swimming pool. **(Red Cross or equivalent certification is required)**

Nurse Asst.(s) Taking care of minor injuries to campers and volunteer staff, dispensing medications and maintaining accurate medical records (First Aid certification required)

Office Assistant Assist in various office and administrative summer camp duties, such as assisting with camper registration & check-out, receptionist, and camper mail.

Store Assistant Serving campers in store operations, assisting in the stocking and cleaning of the store area and keeping accurate records.

Assisting the Facilities Manager in accomplishing various maintenance projects, chores and overseeing the High School Team Staff landscape projects.
