Purpose & Expectations

The purpose for which Indian Hills Camp was founded is to glorify God by reaching and teaching children for Jesus Christ through the use of a Christian camping environment and atmosphere. Utilizing camp activities and fun programming, we build relationships with campers' in order to introduce Christ to an open and receptive heart with kids who do not know Him, as well as, to encourage Christian kids in their regular walk with the Lord.

We are here to serve kids. While at IHC you will **need to ask God** to give you a deeper love of children —not just for certain ones, but for all children. We must constantly realize that every camper who sets foot on these grounds needs to be loved, Christian and non-Christian alike. We need to take seriously that each child who attends IHC was **specifically chosen by God to be here**, and **we too have been chosen by God to impact each child's life for Him at this chosen time.**

Much attention will also be given to **your total development in Christ** while at Indian Hills Camp this summer. We do not think of your spiritual maturing process as one compartment of your life. We want you this summer to not only learn more about Christ, **but to learn to live for Christ at all times.** In other words, He wants the Lordship of Himself to become the norm of your life. We believe that your time at IHC will both impact kids, and bring a life change for you!

Applicant Qualifications

- Born-again Christian with a dedicated heart for Christ and children
- Evidence of spiritual growth, committed to the Lord Jesus Christ, and adhering to Biblical principles
- At least 18 years old or a high school graduate having good physical health, strength, and stamina to participate with children for 12-14 hours of activity each day.

Acceptance Process

- Complete and return application and recommendation form.
- Interview with IHC staff member
- Decisions are made and positions are offered by the IHC Staff (Priority is given to those who return application and recommendations first, and to those who commit to the entire summer.)
- Applicants accept positions by returning all agreement forms.

Each team will spend 1 week working with a refugee church in San Diego, East County or LA. The teams will run Day Camps with IHC programs. Each evening the teams will work in the churches and visit the kid's homes to see where they can help. The second week we will all participate in IHC's annual Mexico Orphan Camp this is a wonderful week serving beautiful orphan kids just south of our border.
